Title: Principal Investigators on Animal Protocols
Creation: 5/24/18
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The purpose of this policy is to define who can be the principal investigator (PI) on an IACUC protocol. In most cases, the PI will be a faculty member, and the personnel on the protocol will report directly to the PI. However, external users have different reporting structures and individuals at Forsyth who are not faculty may be authorized to submit protocols.

PI's must have the authority and responsibility for leading and directing the project, intellectually and logistically. The PI must have direct supervisory authority over all personnel on the protocol. If these conditions cannot be met, a co-PI should be named who has the requisite experience and authority.
